Why French Immersion?

- develops listening and learning skills as well as self-discipline
- increases cognitive abilities, creating a more flexible thinker
- enhances knowledge of and ability to communicate in the first language
- reduces the normal effects of aging on some brain functions
- has been shown to significantly delay the onset of symptoms of dementia
- increases understanding of and respect for other peoples and other cultures
- provides access to a larger pool of information and to more educational and career opportunities
